Swimming will be broke into two sessions to ensure proper life guard coverage.

Session 1: 12:00-1:30

Session 2: 1:30-3:00

Additional Information about the Pool

- **Bring appropriate swim wear and locks** for locker room lockers.
- YMCA provides free towels for day use or you can bring your own.
- Showers are required prior to entering the pool deck.
- A lift is available if a person is not able to access the pool from the stairs.
- Anyone under the age of 12 must pass a height test or swim test to swim in the pool without direct adult supervision. The height test is 42 inches at the armpit. The swim test consists of 25 yards crawl stroke (arms all the way out of the water, no doggy paddle) with their face in the water.
- If a child under the age of 12 cannot pass the swim test or the height test, they must have an adult in the water directly supervising within arms reach. If a parent has more than one child who do not meet these requirements, the other children must wear a U.S. Coast guard approved lifejacket. The YMCA has some life jackets but you are welcome to bring your own.
